EirGrid's East West Interconnector Project (EWIP) was the installation of the electricity link between Ireland and Britain. The project involved the installation of two HVDC and a fibre optic cable 186kms along the Irish Sea bed securing energy for the future and also giving Ireland's expanding wind power networks the opportunity to export energy to the UK.

Osiris' remedial work scope consisted of deburying and repairing the fibre optic cable at two points along with the installation of 94 subsea mattresses at different points along the entire cable route.
