The Inkwazi is an ex German Navy river boat and has been re-purposed as general workboat and pushy tug. This vessel can be used as a general workboat, crew transfers and a diving boat. The propulsion system is unique in that the thrusters can turn 360 degrees, making it very manoeuvrable.
